## Lead and Major Gift Movement Sets Pace for Future Giving

This past week, *Heritage of Faith ~ Vision of Hope* received over \$1.2 million in new gifts and pledges; including three gifts of \$100,000 plus and seven new \$25,000 gifts! Currently, Track 4a parishes are working in the Leadership and Major Phases of their campaigns. Leadership and major gifts should be requested first to 1) build momentum, 2) establish credibility, 3) create enthusiasm and 4) place the parish goal within reach. To date *Heritage of Faith ~ Vision of Hope* has received 776 lead and major gifts totaling \$63,769,294!

- This past week, *St. Philip Neri, Lafayette Hill*, received two six figure gifts of \$100,000 and \$200,000 each! Additionally, the parish received two gifts of \$25,000 each!
- One generous family pledged \$150,000 to *St. Katherine of Siena, Wayne*!
- In the past seven days, *St. Agnes, West Chester*, received two new gifts of \$25,000 each!
- *SS. Peter and Paul, West Chester*, received one gift of \$25,000, last week!
- *St. Timothy, Philadelphia* received its first \$25,000 gift from one generous family!
- *St. John Fisher, Boothwyn*, this past week, received one new gift of \$25,000!
