Campaign Achieves Historic Milestone!

Heritage of Faith ~ Vision of Hope has exceeded its original goal of \$200 million by receiving \$200,158,642 in gifts and pledges from 45,386 families as of October 14, 2010, with the hope of far surpassing goal to address the needs of the Church.

“I would like to express my deepest gratitude to those who have contributed to the success of ***Heritage of Faith ~ Vision of Hope***. Achieving this remarkable milestone was made possible by the generosity of the Catholic community and the leadership and unwavering support of priests and parishioners,” said Cardinal Justin Rigali.

Currently, 47 Track 4a parishes are moving into the Advance Phase of their campaigns. The Track 4a parishes will complete their fundraising efforts and bring the campaign to a conclusion by Christmas time.
