Blessed Teresa of Calcutta Parish, Limerick, Over Goal!!

Congratulations to the parishioners of Blessed Teresa of Calcutta Parish, Limerick and their Pastor, Father Paul Brandt for surpassing their combined campaign goal of \$4 million! The parish received gifts and pledges totaling \$1,167,152 during Commitment Weekend, bringing the total raised to \$4,790,346 or 120% of their combined goal.
