Volunteering Makes a Major Difference!

The leadership shown by the Track 4a Pastors in the *Heritage of Faith ~ Vision of Hope* campaign is generating tremendous results. Currently Pastors are finalizing their Campaign Executive Committees and beginning recruitment for their Major and Advance Phase committees.

Being a volunteer on the parish *Heritage of Faith ~ Vision of Hope* committee is an opportunity to practice Christian stewardship, not only of treasure but by sharing time and talent, too. A volunteer makes a commitment of about two to four hours a week, including a 30-minute report meeting each week. All volunteers receive training for their specific role on the parish committee.
